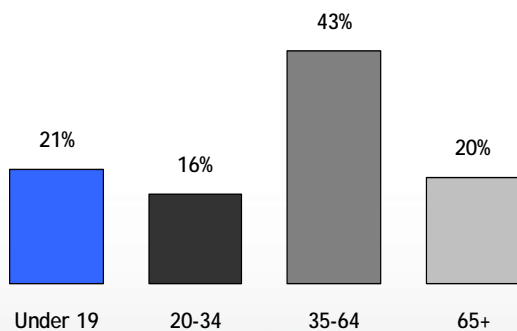

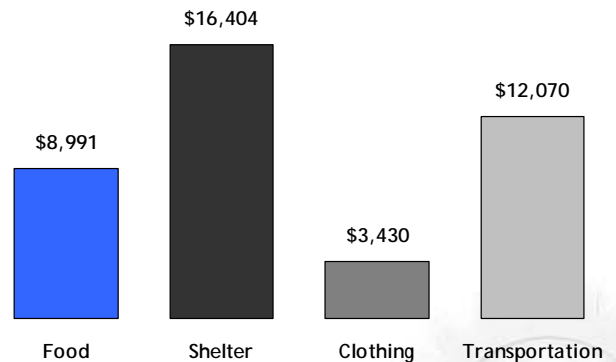
Market Demographic Highlights
