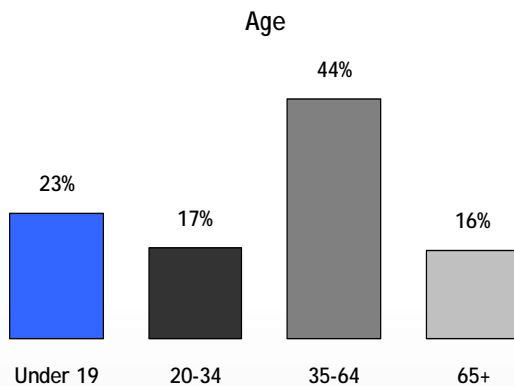

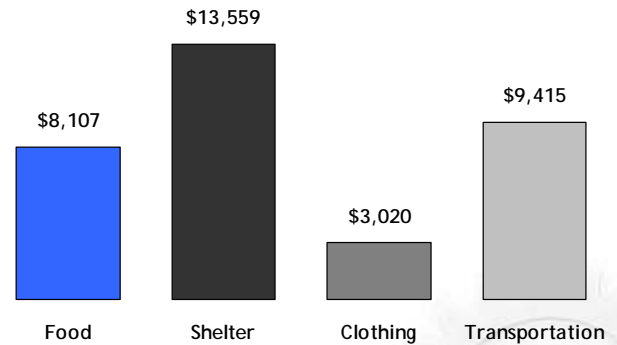


Market Demographic Highlights
